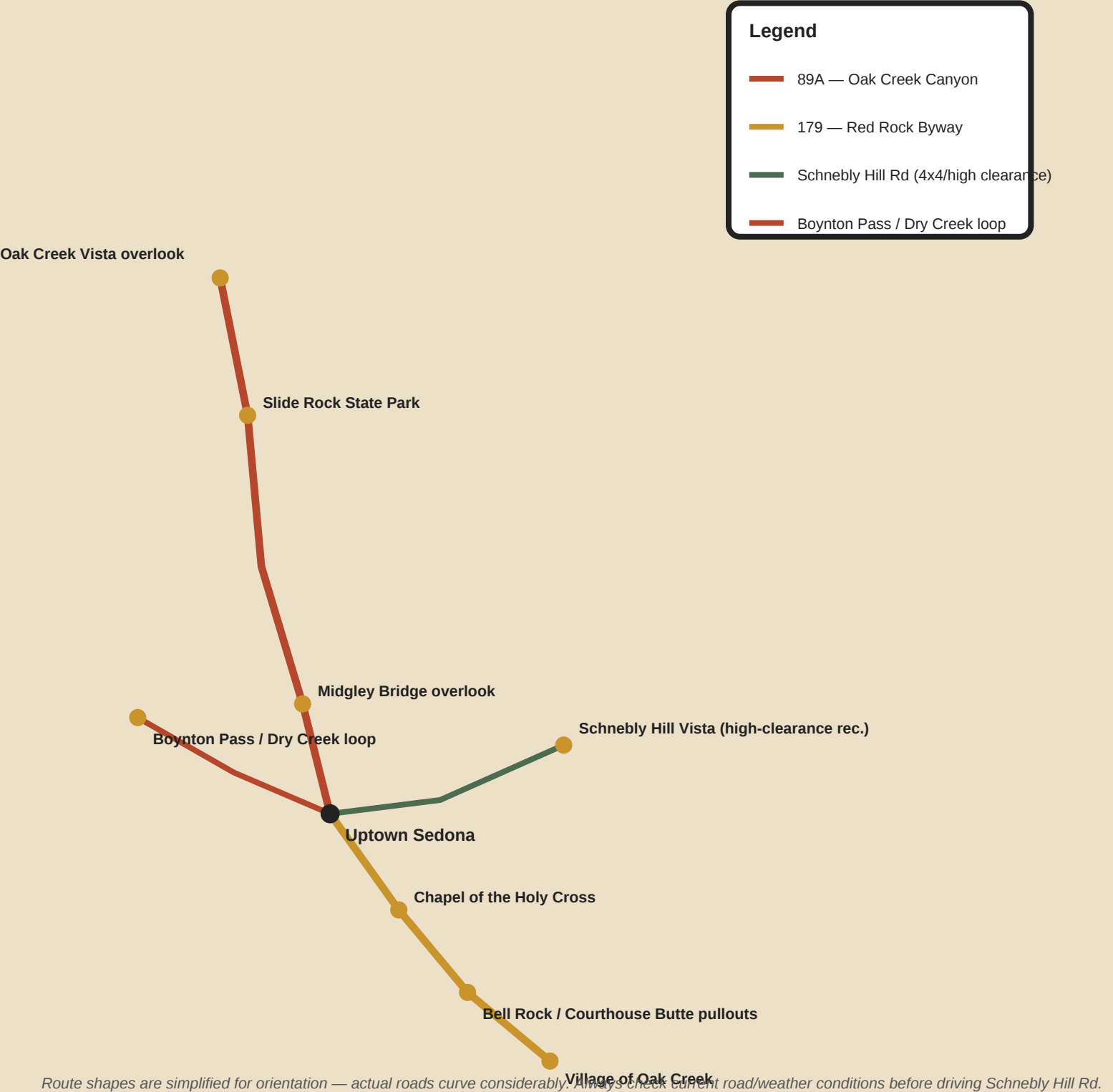


Sedona Scenic Drives (Schematic)

Illustrative route overview, not to scale — pair with a GPS/road map while driving.



Route shapes are simplified for orientation — actual roads curve considerably. Always check current road/weather conditions before driving Schnebly Hill Rd.

Scenic Drive Details

Route	Length	Notes
SR 89A — Oak Creek Canyon (Sedona to Flagstaff)	~14 mi one-way	Winding forested canyon drive; Slide Rock State Park, Midgley Bridge & Oak Creek Vista overlooks; slow switchbacks near the top
SR 179 — Red Rock Scenic Byway (Sedona to I-17)	~7.5 mi one-way	Iconic red-rock views, Chapel of the Holy Cross turnoff, Bell Rock/Courthouse Butte pullouts, Village of Oak Creek
Schnebly Hill Road	~12 mi one-way	Unpaved and rough — high-clearance/4WD recommended beyond the first viewpoint; sweeping panoramic overlooks
Boynton Pass Rd / Dry Creek Rd Loop	~9 mi loop	Paved access to Boynton Canyon, Fay Canyon, and Vulture Arch trailheads through West Sedona backcountry
Airport Road (Airport Mesa)	~1 mi spur	Short steep climb to a 360° overlook — one of the best sunset viewpoints in town

Sunset on 89A/179 westbound and sunrise eastbound both light up the rock faces beautifully — time your drive accordingly.
